Notes / Narratives

On 08/23/13 between approximately 2000 and 2031 hours, unknown suspect entered the Microsoft Store at Fashion Square Mall 7014 E Camelback Rd, and attempted to purchase a laptop using fraudulent currency.

On 08/24/13 at approximately 1221 hours, I was asked to respond to the Microsoft Store inside of Fashion Square Mall (FSM) at 7014 E Camelback Rd. On this day I was in full regulation uniform, in a fully marked patrol vehicle, identifying myself as a police officer with the city of Scottsdale.

I met with the manager who verbally identified himself to me as Jason Swenton. I was informed that on 08/23/13, a subject came into the Microsoft store and tried to purchase a laptop. The sales associate identified the subject as the same person who stole a laptop from them on 07/11/13 (SPD DR 13-19332).

Jason said that when the subject was in the store this time, he selected an item that was approximately \$80 in value, and brought it to the counter to pay for it. Jason did not know at the time of my contact with him what that item specifically was. The sales associate was given 4 \$20 bills by the subject and the sales associate immediately noticed that they were fraudulent. The sales associate told the subject that the money was fraudulent and also told the subject that SPD was being called. The subject left the store quickly and went to his vehicle to attempt to flee the area. No property was taken. SPD officers located the vehicle and determined that the subject was driving with fictitious registration and other traffic violations. Please see SPD DR 13-19280 for further information.

Jason told me that sales associate who interacted with the subject was James Knight. James was not working on the day of my contact with Jason and was not able to interview James directly regarding his contact with the subject on this day.

Microsoft is willing to aid in prosecution. Microsoft will advise when video is available of the incident. FSM will also advise when video is available of the incident.

James did not return the fraudulent money to the subject, and instead turned it into management. Jason said the bills were in the safe within the store. I went with Jason and he opened the safe and handed me 4 \$20 bills. Immediately I recognized these bills to be fraudulent. Signs that they were fraudulent include but are not limited to the fact that the paper felt thicker and crisper than real US currency. There were numerous inconsistencies with the printing and design as well. 2 of the bills had one serial number, and the other 2 had another. Please see the bills for further information. I impounded the bills under this DR.

Jason told me that James told him, that the subject had a wallet full of \$20 bills, which was more than likely additional fraudulent money.

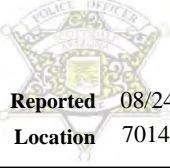
This concludes my involvement with this incident at this time.

Supplement Notes

On 9/11/13 I met with Det. Glass #729 and he briefed me on his case 13-19280 where Kristopher Lauchner was identified as leaving Fashion Square Mall on 8/23/13 in a stolen vehicle.

On 9/11/13 at approximately 1430 hours I went to the Microsoft Store at Fashion Square Mall. I contacted James Knight who was present on 8/23 when the suspect presented counterfeit money for the purchase of an x-box game. James was alerted by the Manager that the suspect had previously stolen a laptop. James watched the suspect as he looked at items in the store to ensure he was not stealing again. When the suspect selected an x-box game he brought it to the register James was working at to pay. The suspect provided four \$20 bills to pay for the item. James realized they were counterfeit bills and tested them using a pen. The pen would leave a light brown color if they were real and a dark almost black color if they were counterfeit. James said the mark stayed almost black on all of the bills. James asked the suspect if he had any other way to pay for the item. The suspect told him that the bills were from the bank and they should be good. James told him the bills were bad and that he was going to keep them. The suspect argued briefly and when James said he could call Police to explain it to him then the suspect walked out. James could see in the suspect's wallet that there was more money in it. The suspect did not try different bills or offer to pay some other way. James thinks the other bills were counterfeit as well.

I explained the photographic line up form to James and had him read it as well. James said he understood and signed the form. I showed James a six picture photo lineup #86554 with Kristopher Lauchner in the upper right #3 position. James studied the lineup and selected #3 as the person that gave him the counterfeit money. James completed the statement and signed the form.

I contacted Microsoft Security in order to get the surveillance video of the transactions. They do have surveillance video but are still working on the request.

On 9/11/13 I went to [REDACTED] which is the last address for Lauchner. The USPS mail carrier was at the community mail box when I arrived. I identified myself as an Officer and she told me that the house had been vacant since May of 2013.

On 8/23/13, at approximately 2045 hours, unknown suspect failed to stop for a traffic violation at [REDACTED] E Chaparral Rd. The suspect fled into the residential neighborhood to the north of Chaparral Rd and abandoned the vehicle at [REDACTED] N 70th Street. Ofc Roberson located the vehicle approximately five minutes after the vehicle fled. The male suspect was not located after perimeter search efforts were unsuccessful.

At approximately 2040 hours, the male subject was observed inside of the Fashion Mall property, specifically in the Microsoft store. Mall security research of past shoplift subjects located surveillance footage of a prior incident involving the same male approximately one month prior (SPD report 13-19332, 7/11/13). During that incident, the suspect took a display laptop from the Microsoft store. Mall security located a silver Kia Optima which the suspect accessed prior to entering the Microsoft store. This vehicle was backed into a parking spot on the 2nd level of the green garage.

When the suspect entered the Microsoft store, I checked the Optima and observed Arizona temporary license plate, [REDACTED]. This plate returned to a Kia Rio, Jeffrey Sheldon, [REDACTED]. A check of the VIN number did not locate any record on file.

The suspect exited the Microsoft store and proceeded to his vehicle. Sgt Bonnette (690) determined that a traffic stop would be appropriate at this point. It was later determined that the suspect provided fraudulent money to Microsoft during this incident (SPD report 13-19333).

I located the vehicle pulling onto Goldwater Blvd (N/B). I attempted to catch up to the Optima and observed it pull into the mall parking lot located around the Camelview theatre and Dillards department store. I observed the vehicle pull down a row of cars near the parking garage and lost sight of it. Within two minutes, I located it leaving the mall property onto 68th Street northbound. I attempted to catch up to the vehicle and did so at [REDACTED] E Chaparral. I was operating a semi-marked police vehicle with red and blue emergency lights. The driver turned E/B onto Chaparral Drive. At [REDACTED] E Chaparral Rd, I activated the emergency lights and siren on the vehicle. Within two seconds, I observed the driver accelerate in the Kia to approximately 50 MPH. I immediately pulled to a stop on Chaparral. I observed the Optima turn N/B onto 70th Place. After losing sight of the Optima, I pulled into the neighborhood and stopped at 70th Place and Pasadena Ave to await responding officers.

I observed a man, later identified as resident Mark Provinzano of [REDACTED] waving a flashlight at me. I moved to his location and he reported the Optima went S/B on 71st Place and turned E/B. At this point, Ofc Roberson reported the location of the vehicle via radio. I responded to that location to commence a perimeter detail. The suspect was not located. Resident Robert Cooper, [REDACTED], did not hear anything and did not know why the vehicle was in his driveway. I noted the vehicle had various contents and was in good condition.

I spoke briefly with resident Eleanor Mavor of [REDACTED]. She reported that a male had knocked on her front door and asked her to call a taxi. The male also offered Mavor \$100.00 to give him a ride. Mavor told the male, "no" and shut the door.

The vehicle was processed for evidence by CSS Oleksik prior to removal to the police impound lot at 7601 E McKellips Drive.

Subsequent follow-up investigation determined the vehicle was stolen from Scottsdale. Per a Carfax report, the Optima showed a stolen status on 7/15/13 from Mark Mitsubishi. An NICB check showed that Federated Insurance linked a claim to this vehicle with a contact of Josh Spencer (general manager) of Mark Kia/Mitsubishi.

On 9/3/13, I spoke with Spencer by telephone. He stated the vehicle was received into inventory on 7/9/13. He stated it was not located during an audit on 7/15/13 and both keys were gone. Spencer did not file a police report. He stated that it was likely stolen after it was unloaded with the keys still inside.

CSS Oleksik processed the vehicle prior to tow. It should be noted that video evidence at the mall showed Lauchner to be possession of the Kia Optima on 7/11/13 during incident 13-19332. This would have been two days after the vehicle was delivered to Mark Kia and prior to the audit by Mark Kia on 7/15/13 which showed the vehicle missing.

The temporary license plate returned to a Kia Rio, with the last four of the VIN number [REDACTED]. It was registered to a Jeffrey Sheldon, date of birth [REDACTED]. I observed Sheldon's MVD photograph dated 2011 and observed that Sheldon was not the same male that I observed inside of the mall. Sheldon was listed at 5'7 which did not match the suspect as well.

The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 40 to 50 years of age, with a bald head. He was approximately 6'0 feet tall and 190 lbs. There was medical paperwork for Kristopher Cauchner of [REDACTED]. I located a subject with that registered MVD address by the name of Kristopher Lauchner. I reviewed his MVD photograph and as well as prior booking photographs and recognized him to be the suspect in this case. MVD records showed Lauchner to be 5'10 and 190 lbs. I recognized his facial features and structure. Lauchner showed extensive criminal history to include a seven year prison sentence for theft of means.

Additional information will be forthcoming.

On 10/2/13, this case advanced. A check of the Maricopa county Superior Court indicated that Lauchner had court scheduled for 10/2/13 at 0830 hours at 201 W Jefferson Street in Phoenix for case CR2012-151899. Members of the Scottsdale ROP unit responded to courtroom 804 and placed Lauchner under arrest at approximately 0948 hours.

On 10/2/13, I responded to the District II jail. I observed that Lauchner was wearing the same black shirt from the mall surveillance video. It is a button down shirt, black in color with wrist cuffs which display a pattern when folded back. The wrist cuff design matched the collar design. I also observed Lauchner's chest tattoo above the line of his shirt which was consistent with the mall video footage as well. The shirt was impounded as evidence.

I interviewed Lauchner with Det Toschik in the west interview room located near the bike unit office. We escorted him to and from the interview room without incident. He was in handcuffs and leg shackles. At 1100 hours, I read Miranda rights to Lauchner. He stated, "yes sir" when asked if he understood his rights. Lauchner provided contact information upon request. He stated he owns Vapor Cleaning Services and cleans tile and grout occasionally. Lauchner stated his current telephone number is [REDACTED] with Cricket. Lauchner stated he does not use drugs since his prison release in April 2013. He would later admit to using methamphetamine on a regular basis. Lauchner stated he has not filed taxes for several years. He stated he was not associated with any gang activity. He stated he plays pool and cleans floors occasionally to support himself.

Lauchner stated he has a tattoo in German which means, "My honor is truth" in a rocker design on his upper chest. He also had a large back tattoo as well. He denied any political tattoos.

I told Lauchner that I was going to ask him a question to gauge whether he would be honest or not. I asked him why he thought he was in Scottsdale today. Lauchner replied that it could be a few reasons. Lauchner stated that when he would get high, "one of my things was shoplifting". He cited electronics and small "shit" as targeted items. Lauchner mentioned that he owes \$600.00 to a bondsman for his Harley Davidson motorcycle.

Lauchner mentioned that he was "high" in Scottsdale a year ago. I told him that in August 2013 that he was at Fashion Square mall and dumped a stolen car. I showed him two still photographs of Lauchner in the green garage. Lauchner began to act as if he did not know anything about the car. Lauchner then explained that he rented the car from a drug friend named Dan, last unknown, for \$100.00 every three days. He stated he rented the car in late July. Lauchner stated that Dan did not tell him it was stolen, but told him that his girlfriend Amanda, last unknown, leased the car under a fraudulent name and they would be re-possessing it. Lauchner stated, "I knew there was something shady about the car". Lauchner stated there was no contract and Dan does not rent cars or own a business that rents cars.

Lauchner stated he needed transportation. I asked him why he had run from police on 8/23/13 in the car. Lauchner stated he sold an iPhone and Nintendo Wii on Craigslist for \$300.00 on 8/22/13. Lauchner did not know the person who bought the items and had no information about the Craigslist transaction. He stated he entered the Microsoft store to buy a game for ex's son. Lauchner stated a Microsoft employee told him the twenty bills were fake. He stated he was told that Microsoft would keep the money and talk to police. Lauchner stated he left because he didn't need the drama.

Lauchner stated he saw a truck with red and blue lights behind him. He stated he was "scared" because the Microsoft employee mentioned the police. He stated he was paranoid about the incident as well. He stated he valued his freedom and had too much going on to stop. Lauchner stated he was high on meth during this incident. He stated the truck turned on his lights and "it was obvious it was after me". Lauchner stated he turned, and didn't see the truck again, and parked the car and walked away, and called Dan to get his vehicle.

Lauchner could not produce a phone number for Dan. Det Toschik received permission from Lauchner to look for Dan's number in his cell phone. Lauchner expressed remorse about Dan and hinted that he knew more information about Dan.

I stated to Lauchner that while he was being honest to answer whether he took a laptop on display at Microsoft and run out of the store. Lauchner disagreed that he "ran". I reminded him that he was video. Lauchner stated that "yeah" when asked if he took a laptop from Microsoft. He stated he sold it for \$500 or \$600 to a drug dealer to pay his rent. He said this was a hand to hand transaction, not on-line.

Lauchner stated he is not being paid by anyone to investigate drug transactions. He stated he had a traumatic loss of his son in 1999 which led to drug use and depression. Lauchner stated he did well on probation and parole, when he was accountable. Lauchner stated that Clarissa St Peter is his current live-in girlfriend.

Lauchner recalled contact with Phoenix PD in July 2013 concerning a pool cue. He stated he assumed that the license plate on

the Kia Optima was placed there by Dan or the dealership. He stated he did not touch the license plate. Lauchner stated his father owns two homes in Scottsdale.

Lauchner wanted to discuss a "deal" for drug information that he had. Det Toschik and I explained that we were not in a position to make any deals and would only discuss the Scottsdale incidents.

Lauchner confirmed that he knows right from wrong when sober and becomes impulsive when high. He stated he is diagnosed manic bi-polar. He stated he knows there is a connection between his behavior and drugs. Lauchner denied knowing the bills were fake. He then stated he "saw details that were so stupid, it was obvious" in reference to the bills. Lauchner stated that he could not manage himself well on drugs.

Lauchner stated the iPhone and iPad in his possession belonged to him. A later check indicated the electronics were not stolen. Det Toschik impounded these items as safekeeping.

I asked Lauchner what his plan was for the future. Lauchner did not seem to have any plan and talked about drug activity. Lauchner stated he intends to have a SSMI assessment in the near future. He stated he has been in prison on two different occasions.

Det Toschik assisted Lauchner to call his aunt so that she could retrieve her truck from the downtown Phoenix area. Upon completion of this call, the interview was completed after Lauchner again expressed his interest to provide information to detectives. I placed a copy of the interview onto disk and impounded the disk at the Via Linda station.

On 10/2/13, I completed a submittal with MCAO requesting that Lauchner be charged with one count of auto theft, 13-1814.A1, one count of forgery, 13-2002.A3, and one count of shoplift, 13-1805.A1 for his involvement in these incidents in Scottsdale. Lauchner was held in-custody.

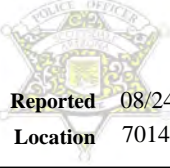

On 10/02/13 I was working as a ROP Detective. I was assisting Det. Glass (#729) with his investigation regarding Offender Kristopher Lauchner. I was specifically tasked with apprehending Lauchner. I discovered that Lauchner had a court date at 201 W. Jefferson #804 at 0830 hours in Phoenix on Wednesday 10/02/13.

Lauchner has an extensive criminal history including violent crimes against police and weapons violations. Based on his criminal past it was determined that the ROP unit would arrest Lauchner after his court appearance thus lowering the probability of a violent encounter based on the fact that he had passed through the court security screening process.

I observed Lauchner arrive to court and sat in the courtroom during his conference. As I was sitting in the courtroom waiting for Lauchner to be called for his conference, he sat down beside me. He asked why we were following him. I told him that we were Glendale PD detectives that were in court for his case because we were subpoenaed. I told him that I could not discuss details of the case with him. He said he had information about drugs that he would like to talk to me about after court. After his court business was complete, as he had exited the doors to the courtroom into the hallway, myself and another detective took him into custody at 0948 hours. I placed him in double locked handcuffs behind his back. As we were waiting for the elevator a female approached Lauchner that I believed to be his lawyer. She told him to be quiet. He appeared to acknowledge her by shaking his head.

We then walked Lauchner out to my assigned vehicle. Based on his extreme violence potential, and the fact that my vehicle does not have a secure area, I placed his ankles in a RIPP restraint and affixed it to the mount of the front seat. He was seat belted in. Det. Gieber (#1131) rode with us in my vehicle as we drove to the District Two Jail. We did not discuss the crimes being investigated with Lauchner during the ride to the Jail.

I then sat in the interview with Det. Glass and Lauchner. The interview was audio and video recorded. Det. Glass completed a supplement regarding the interview. At no time did Lauchner invoke any of his Miranda rights during the interview.

It should be noted that when I went to the recording equipment to burn a copy of the disk of the interview I noticed I had not properly enabled the audio. The DVD of the interview room only contains video and no audio, however, Det. Glass had audio recorded the entire interview with his digital recorder. I impounded the DVD of the video at District Three as evidence.

I also impounded Lauchner's iPhone and iPad mini as safe keeping at District Three.

This ended my involvement in this matter.
